



How to find a client using the PID:

Some reports have a PersonalID (PID) instead of a unique identifier (UID). PID is not searchable in the client search bar. If you need to access a client that is only identified by PID, you can go straight to their profile from any other clarity client profile screen:

Report may look like this:
